the bolt 5.10-, b) move 3'-4' left and up and then back above the bolt 5.9, c) traverse all the way left till in the chimney up to lower angle ground then return to bolt line 5.7+PG/R. Continue up the face to the last bolt, and move right onto the prow, and up to the ledge above. The anchors are located on a small stance above the vegetated ledge. It is suggested that the leader just clip this anchor, then traverse down and left to the spacious, treed ledge and belay there from natural anchors to be more comfortable (the next pitch starts directly above this, eliminating the need for a belay shift.) **5.9 or 5.10-, 11 bolts, pro to 1', 125'**

P4-The left weakness, which is a right facing wide crack, is Hardskins of Our Forefathers (#22), while the right one, which is a right facing corner to a small roof bearing a bolt, is the start for this pitch. Above the roof, a ledge is followed by a short section of right facing flake/corner. Move up this to its end, then head right past two bolts to the next crack over. When this crack ends, follow bolts up to the final flakes and anchor. **5.9, 8 bolts, pro to 4", 160'**

P5-Climb straight up the steep wall above, to interesting plated rock finishing on ledge with anchor. **5.10-, 10 bolts, pro to 4", 145'**

P6-Continue up past 3 bolts to the ledge and belay. **5.6, 3 bolts, pro to 4", 50'**
